

***Meneleonus virgatus* Remark**

REMARKS. *Meneleonus signaticollis* and *M. anxius* were both described from Persia, whereas *M. virgatus* was described from Caucasus. All specimens examined from Caucasus differ from those from Persia in the key-characters cited by Faust (1904) for the distinction between the two species. It seems thus that the two taxa are geographical allopatric vicariants, with *M. virgatus* present in the Caucasian regions, expanding to Iran only in Iranian Azerbaijan (Khoy).
